The Tillsonburg Community Centre offers a variety of fun, interactive and co-operative day camps throughout the year.

In this package you'll find general information about our March Break Camp, PA Day Camp and Summer Camp programs.

Note for Summer Camp: A detailed Summer Camp Information Package is provided to parents/guardians of registered participants closer to the camp date(s).

Camper Ages

March Break Camp and PA Day Camp are for ages 5 - 12 years old.

Summer Camp is divided into junior and senior age groups:

- Junior Camp is for ages 5 - 8 years old
- Senior Camp is for ages 9 - 12 years old

Camp Hours

Camp Sign-In: 7:00 AM – 9:00 AM

Camp Program Hours: 9:00 AM – 4:00 PM

Camp Sign-Out: 4:00 PM – 5:00 PM*

* If your camper is not picked up by 5:00 PM your account will be charged \$5.00 for every additional 10 minutes they are at camp.

Code of Conduct

Campers will be asked to commit to the following statements:

1. I will be respectful to my fellow campers
2. I will be respectful to my youth leaders
3. I will be respectful to my environment
4. I will be respectful to myself

It is our utmost priority to provide campers with an environment where they can build self-confidence, make new friends and get the best possible camp experience. We encourage open communication between staff, campers and parents/guardians.

Please inform us of any family or behavioral issues concerning your child(ren). Our staff will make every effort to accommodate your child's needs.

Staff reserve the right to dismiss any participant who we deem to be a hazard to the safety and rights of others, or who appears to have rejected reasonable controls of the program.

Sign-in & Out Procedures

Arrive at the **East Entrance** of the Tillsonburg Community Centre. Proceed to your designated sign-in location (provided to you upon registration), following the posted signage. Staff will be available to guide you if required.

Campers are not permitted to leave without being signed out. All caregivers must bring proof of ID upon sign-out. Written permission and identification will be required if a child is to be picked up by anyone not listed as a primary caregiver.

SIGN-IN



Arrive between 7:00 AM - 9:00 AM

- **March Break Camp and PA Day Camp:** Arrive at the East Entrance and proceed to the sign-in location provided upon registration. Camp is located in the Lions Den or Marwood Lounge, unless otherwise noted.

Note: March Break Camp and PA Day Camp require a parent/guardian enter the building to sign-in the child.

- **Summer Camp:** Arrive at the East Entrance and proceed to the sign-in location provided upon registration.

SIGN-OUT



Arrive between 4:00 PM - 5:00 PM

- Go to the sign-in location. Notify the program staff of your camper's name and follow any further sign-out instructions (proof of ID is required).
- Please ensure camper has all of their belongings before leaving.



Camper Belongings

We encourage our campers to label all of their belongings with their name in order to avoid losing them. Please do not send your camper with toys, money (unless for camp-related purchases), electronics, card games of any kind, or sharp objects. We cannot be responsible for any valuables brought to camp. Occasionally your camper may be requested to bring specific items for special crafts or activities.

HEALTH & SAFETY



COVID-19

Camp staff and campers will follow rules and guidelines from the Province of Ontario as well as Southwestern Public Health to ensure safety at all times.

COVID-19 Symptoms at Camp

Safety is our number one priority at camp. If your camper experiences any symptoms related to COVID-19, please keep your child home and call the Community Centre to inform us that your child will be absent. If your camper did not have symptoms prior to arriving at camp, but later in the day show signs, a parent or caregiver will be called to pick up the camper immediately.

EpiPens and Inhalers

We request that any camper requiring an EpiPen or inhaler bring it in a separate fanny pack or bag that they can wear all day. Please check the expiration dates on the supplies prior to the start of camp. Let your child's leader know that there is an EpiPen/Inhaler and where it is kept.



Nut-Free Policy

Due to the growing number of severe nut-related allergies, please **DO NOT** send peanut butter, nuts or foods that contain nut by-products with your camper. While it is impossible to guarantee a nut-free environment, participant safety is our first priority. Thank you for your cooperation in this serious matter.



CAMPER'S CHECKLIST

What to bring...



Bathing Suit and Towel

We visit Lake Lisgar Waterpark on a daily basis for swimming in the summer, and use the indoor pool for March Break Camp and PA Day Camp. Please bring a bathing suit and towel.



Play Clothing & Running Shoes

In the summer, we spend the majority of the day outside. Please ensure that your child is appropriately dressed for the weather and camp activities.



Skates and Helmet

Campers who wish to skate during camps that offer time for ice skating must bring their own skates and helmet, along with any other attire that would be appropriate for skating. NO HOCKEY STICKS PERMITTED.



Summer Sun Safety Items

In the summer, campers must bring sunscreen of a SPF 30 or higher, a hat and sunglasses to camp each day. Sunscreen will be re-applied throughout the day.

Don't forget lunch and a water bottle!



Lunch and Snacks

Pack a nutritious lunch, extra snacks, juice and a water bottle. Ensure all foods and snacks are NUT-FREE.



Water Bottle

All campers need to bring a water bottle to camp EVERY day. Campers will have opportunities to re-fill their bottles throughout the day.
