



Public Notice: Transportation Master Plan Open House

June 3, 2024 -- The Town of Tillsonburg is currently completing a Transportation Master Plan. A Transportation Master Plan (TMP) is a strategic policy document that guides how a municipality's transportation system will grow and develop over the long term. The Plan will:

- examine current transportation issues within the community
- assess existing and future growth patterns
- determine the need for transportation improvements
- establish policies to support the plan and maintain the transportation network

The Transportation Master Plan works together with a municipality's Official Plan, which directs land use and development patterns. It also considers other master plans such as those concerning municipal servicing, parks and recreation, and economic development.

The Transportation Master Plan is being undertaken in accordance with the requirements outlined in the 2023 Municipal Class Environmental Assessment (EA) Approach #1 (an approved process under the Ontario *Environmental Assessment Act*).
