What is the Fee Assisted Recreational Experiences Program?

The Town of Tillsonburg – Recreation, Culture & Parks Department provide a Recreation Fee Subsidy Program to Oxford County residents who are in financial need. Recreation Fee Subsidy enhances access to recreation and is available for admissions and program registration at the Tillsonburg Community Centre., A proof of income is required to determine eligibility for the program.

Who is eligible for the program?

To be eligible for assistance, applicants must be:

- residents of Oxford County; and
- have a total household income below the Stats Canada Low-Income Cut off's (LICO's). Proof of financial status must be provided.

How does the fee subsidy work?

Once a client has been approved for the Program, they will be contacted by the F.A.R.E Administrator. A meeting will be set up to review program options and provide leisure counselling with the client. Each application is received on a case by case basis and may vary depending on program selections. All successful applicants will receive a Lake Lisgar Waterpark season's pass, admission to indoor Community Swims and Skates as well.



The Goal of the F.A.R.E Program is to provide healthy recreational opportunities for everyone.

How do I apply?

Step 1: Obtain an application form

Step 2: Complete the application form and attach the requested eligibility documentation see list on the application form).

Step 4: Staff will contact you to inform you of your application status.

Is there a deadline for applications?

No, you can apply to the program at any time, provided funding is available.

Can I get a refund for programs I have already taken?

No. Subsidies are only provided for future activities and not for previous registrations for upcoming programs or programs taken in the past.

Will the program ever change?

Yes. This program is on-going and therefore may change depending on funding availability. We want to ensure that those who qualify for funding use it. If a qualified participant is not attending programs or facilities they will forfeit their spot in the program. This would allow another participant the opportunity to utilize the service.
