



CARDBOARD

Examples: Pizza boxes, delivery boxes, moving boxes, shoe boxes
 Rules: Must be flattened, must be no larger than 60 x 60 cm



BOXBOARD

Examples: Cereal boxes, tissue boxes, egg cartons, toilet paper rolls
 Rules: Must be flattened, must be empty



PAPER LAMINATED PACKAGING

Examples: Pet food bags, paper bags and plates, ice cream containers, hot and cold coffee cups, cookie-dough tubes
 Rules: Must be empty and free of food, remove lids



PLASTIC PACKAGING (small)

Examples: Hand-sanitizer bottles, medication bottles, blister packs, plant pots
 Rules: Must be empty and clean, keep lids on



CARTONS

Examples: Beverage cartons, cream cartons, sugar cartons, soup and sauce cartons
 Rules: Must be empty and clean, keep lids on, no alcoholic beverage containers



PLASTIC PACKAGING

Examples: Food trays, salad containers, yogurt cups, peanut-butter jars, bakery clamshells, egg containers, plastic cups, plastic tubs and lids
 Rules: Must be empty and clean, keep lids on, no alcoholic beverage containers



HARD PLASTIC CONTAINERS

Examples: Laundry-detergent jugs, household-cleaner bottles, shampoo, salad-dressing bottles, condiment bottles, dish-soap bottles
 Rules: Must be empty and clean, keep lids on, no alcoholic beverage containers



TUBES

Examples: Toothpaste tubes, deodorant tubes, hand-cream tubes
 Rules: Must be empty and free of residue, keep lids on



FLEXIBLE PLASTIC PACKAGING

Examples: Dry-cleaning bags, bread bags, newspaper/flyer sleeves, overwrap, coffee or deli pouches, chip bags, bubble wrap, snack wrappers, cereal-box liners, plastic gift bags

Rules: Must be flattened, must be empty



FOAM PACKAGING

Examples: Meat trays, takeout containers, foam cups, foam plates, foam bowls, protective foam from product packaging

Rules: Remove film wrapping and remove absorbent pads from meat trays
Must be empty and free of residue



METAL & ALUMINUM

Examples: Food cans, metal lids, cookie tins, coffee and tea tins, beverage cans, aluminum foil, pie plates, frozen-food trays

Rules: Must be empty and free of food, keep lids on, No alcoholic beverage containers



GLASS

Examples: Clear and coloured glass, food jars, glass bottles, cosmetic jars, spice bottles, oil and vinegar bottles, non-alcoholic glass beverage bottles

Rules: Must be empty and clean, lids off, no alcoholic beverage bottles



PAPER

Examples: Paper of any colour. Flour bags, prescription bags, paper produce bags. Notepads, loose paper, file folders, printed materials. Newspapers, flyers, brochures, magazines. Greeting cards, envelopes, gift boxes

Rules: Must be empty, remove rope handles from gift bags
Shredded paper: place in a tied clear plastic bag
Do not include hardcover or softcover books/novels



AEROSOL CONTAINERS

Examples: Food-spray cans, hair spray, air fresheners, shaving cream, deodorant

Rules: Must be empty, keep lids on. Aerosols with toxic, corrosive, or flammable symbols are not accepted, except for:
Cooking-oil sprays and products designed for food
Hairspray, cosmetics, and other products meant for use on hair or skin
